This Implementation Plan will help you recognize children's current developmental stage in the social and emotional domain of anger and impulse control and develop a lesson/or lessons that support development in one of the four areas of anger and impulse control. It is important to try out the things you have learned in the training so you can really understand them. The trainer will read this Implementation Plan and give you some more ideas for ways that you can do even better in the future.

The Core Competency this Implementation Plan addresses is: Respond and interact positively with all children and reinforce appropriate and/or expected behaviors.

DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Observe the children in your classroom. Identify the ways you already build relationships with them.
- 2. After you have identified what you do, choose two new strategies discussed in the training that would assist you with building or enhancing you relationship with the children in you care (refer to your notes to identify a strategy).
- 3. Using the two strategy ideas you chose, develop any materials you will need to implement those strategies.
- 4. Implement the first strategy in Week One.
- 5. Take video or photographic examples of your implementation of the strategy.
- 6. Implement the second strategy in Week Two.
- 7. Take video or photographic examples of your implementation of the strategy.
